Exclusive Product Access


Australia Post, the Perth Mint and the Royal Australian Mint

Access to obtain exclusive product will be managed via queues until such time as the queues finish (at the discretion of the individual administration). There will be a separate queue for each administration. Each of these queues will access the Dealer Floor via a separate entrance. To obtain exclusive product from more than one administration, after purchase you will need to exit the building and rejoin a queue.

There will be a separate entrance for General Admission. Queues will be signposted, and more detail will be available on arrival at the venue.

The Perth 2023 perfin creator makes the Western Australian swan perfin. The perfin will be available on the specially designed souvenir cover stamp at the show.

Perth 2023 Historic Displays

In addition to everything else, Perth 2023 will include two historical philatelic related displays: radios and bikes.

Centenary of Radio Broadcasting in Australia

November 2023 marks 100 years of radio broadcasting in Australia.

In May 1923 the Commonwealth Government devised a restricted scheme to introduce radio broadcasting into Australia.

The first radio station to be licenced under this scheme was 2FC in Sydney, which received its licence on 1 July 1923. However, its opposition, 2SB, beat 2FC to the airwaves by commencing its broadcasting on 23 November 1923.

The curious thing about this restricted scheme was that the radio broadcasting stations were to be licensed to both broadcast and to sell radios. The radios were designed to receive broadcasts only from the radio station that sold the radio receiver.

Subsequently, this restricted scheme was altered to enable the development of radio broadcasting in Australia, as it exists today.

Postal Bikes & Penny Farthings

Since the development of the postage stamp and the bicycle, both have shared a long and close association.

In recognition of this association the Western Australian Historical Cycle Club Inc. will display a range of historic and vintage bicycles at Perth 2023.

The display will include examples from the earliest designs from the 1860s through to the 1990s (including the famous penny farthings).

Transport

Bus Service

A free **Red CAT** Bus Route - Gloucester Park to the CBD and return runs at least every 15 minutes seven days per week.

Train

If you're travelling by train into Perth, the **Red CAT** picks up at Perth Railway Station. Look for the Red Cat signed bus stop in front of the station.

Alight the at the Hale Street/WACA Cat Stop (No: 28508) to access Gloucester Park through the main entrance.

Airport Rail Linkages

If you are travelling to Perth by a domestic or international flight there is train access to the Perth Railway Station in the heart of the CBD.

Trains operate every 12 minutes during peak period, every 15 minutes during the day and every 30 minutes at night from Airport Central and Redcliffe stations to Perth Station in the CBD.

Airport Central is attached to **Terminals T1 and T2** by a moving walkway. One-way tickets to Perth Railway Station cost \$A5:00 and are available at the staffed service desk just outside the platform entry gates of Airport Central.

Terminals T3 and T4 connect with the Perth Airport Line at Redcliffe station. A bus link departs Terminals T3 and T4 to the Redcliffe Station. Look for **Bus No 292** outside the terminal building at the northern end.

Purchase your ticket from the No 292 bus driver. Cost: \$A5:00 cash.

This ticket entitles you to travel on the bus to Redcliffe Station and then into Perth Station in the heart of the CBD.

Public Car Parking

Gloucester Park is a 5-minute walk from the City of Perth's Queens Garden Car Park in Nelson Crescent, East Perth, in which there are 863 car bays. Cash and credit card payment is available at the parking meter.

Free parking at Gloucester Park will be available during the weekend. Volunteers will receive free parking on site at all times.
